VOLUNTEER COACH BACKGROUND CHECK REQUIREMENTS

Coaches must complete and pass an on-line national volunteer background check through the Bethel School District at- <https://bethelvolunteers.hrmpius.net/> before receiving rosters or attending practices.

Coaches Code of Conduct

- **Umpires-** Adhere to our zero tolerance policy- PLEASE do not address, yell at or criticize the umpires. If you feel the umpires are not making the correct calls, address it with the field supervisor who can talk to them. Most of the umpires are high school students doing their best. Supervisors are there to help everyone so please seek the out. If something is not resolved on the field, please email the director about the situation.
- **Parent and Player Conduct-** Coaches are responsible for both their parents and players conduct. Coaches need to go over the league rules with parents and players at your first practice to ensure that everyone knows the rules. If parents get out of line, yell at officials etc., coaches need to remind them about the parent code of conduct and zero tolerance policy concerning our officials!
- **Sportsmanship/Good Role Model-** Coaches need to teach good sportsmanship and role model good sportsmanship as well!
- **Score-** Do your best to not run up the score, put players in different positions etc.
- ***Follow all Bethel School District Policies on School Property-***
NO DOGS! NO SMOKING-VAPING! NO DRONES!
- **Disciplinary Procedures and Penalties-** Any coach, parent, team or player that does not follow the code of conduct will be issued either a written warning, suspension and other penalties.

Our hope is that our participants follow the code of conduct and that the program is a safe and fun environment for all!

FIELDS

Clean up: Please make sure that you take care of the schools and clean up the field after every practice and game including water bottles, garbage and any lost and found items.

Dirt Infields: Please bring a rake and shovel with you to practice and rake in and level out the field after practice, especially around the pitchers mound and home plate where holes are formed from pitching, batting and catching. This helps to avoid puddles on the fields.

Please do NOT practice on fields that have been lined for games. Especially on Fridays!

WEATHER & FIELD CONDITIONS

THE RULE IS: If Bethel Schools are closed for any reason, or released early due to inclement weather, all Bethel Rec. activities are canceled.

Practices: Coaches will judge the field & weather conditions for **practices**. They will contact their teams.

Games will be postponed or canceled only by the Bethel Recreation Association Director or Field Supervisor. We will update the home page of our website with any updates. If games have not been canceled by 8:00AM (Saturdays) or 4:00PM (weeknights) by the association, both teams must appear at the game site ready to play or the non-appearing team shall forfeit the game regardless of playing conditions due to weather or otherwise. The Adult Umpire or Field Supervisor shall be the sole judge as to the condition of the field of play. Games must be played as scheduled or forfeited.

Practices, Equipment, Games

- Practices begin the week of **April 14th**. Coaches need to schedule their practice times with their Program Coordinator.
- Please contact all your players no later than **Friday, March 28** with your practice days and times and any other helpful information like what they need to bring such as gloves, protective cup, water bottle etc.!
- Equipment will be checked out by coaches at the BR Shed.
- Games will be played at Bethel MS & HS, Spanaway MS, Cedarcrest MS & Thompson Elem.
- Coaches are responsible for returning all equipment to the Field Supervisor at your last game or to the Bethel Recreation Shed the week after the end of the season!
- If equipment is not returned, coaches will not be able to return to coach and will be billed for the cost of equipment replacement.
- The **Common Questions & Answers** Sheet has all the information on uniforms, team photos, practices, games etc.
