

2026 Fall Cheerleading Common Q & A



Games

League games will begin Saturday, September 26 –October 31. Our cheer squads will be scheduled to cheer for our K-2nd and 3rd-6th grade flag football teams. The Director will schedule games on Saturdays between 9am and 4pm at Bethel Schools. Cheer squads will be scheduled to cheer for 6 games.

Game schedules will be available on our website at bethelrec.org by **Monday, September 21** and will be updated regularly. ***If a coach has a specific team that they would like to cheer for or if you have any conflicts with any specific dates/days/times for games, you need to email jmoxley@bethelrec.org by Thursday, September 10.** Every effort will be made to accommodate coaching requests but is not guaranteed. Once game schedules are complete, games will not be rescheduled.

Pre-Season Games & Official Training

Our Cheer practice games will be held **Saturday, September 19**. These games are intended to give our cheer squads and football teams some needed game situation practice and to train our officials. Please inform your parents that this is also our official training and is meant to be a fun learning experience for everyone. You will be contacted/emailed after the coaches meeting by the director to schedule your squad to cheer. ***This is optional and not all squads will be scheduled to cheer for a practice game.*** Practice game schedules will be posted and emailed to coaches by Monday, September 14.

Uniforms

Bethel Rec provides team t-shirts that are to be the outermost garment during games. Shirts will be available for pick-up at the Lineup by **Wednesday, September 23**. If players were added to your roster late, their shirts may be ready at a later date. One head coach shirt is given per team. If you have an assistant coach that wants a coach shirt and they want to pay an additional fee of \$6.50 plus tax (size 2X-5X add \$2) you must inform your program coordinator of their shirt size by Tuesday, September 16th.

Teams can add names to the back of their uniforms at a minimal cost (\$5.50 plus tax per shirt) **only if all parents agree** and there is financial assistance offered for those that cannot afford the additional fee. This is optional and may delay getting shirts back by Sept. 23 if ordered late. **NAME ORDER DEADLINE: THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 17.** Coaches will coordinate names on shirts with the shirt company. Additional assistant coach shirt fee and the cost for shirt names must be paid when you pick up your shirts!

Equipment Needed

We ask that all children have proper tennis shoes. **No jewelry (INCLUDES EARRINGS).** Each participant will be given a set of poms, a t-shirt and Bow from Bethel Rec. Cheer squads are encouraged to be creative and can make their own signs etc. to use while cheering.

Practices

Practices begin the week of September 14. **Coaches must contact parents by September 11 with practice information.** Practices will be held at your home school unless your home school does not have enough girls to complete a squad or your school does not have appropriate facilities to practice. Your Program Coordinator will place you at another local school. The head coach and the availability of facilities given by the schools time and days. All practices must be scheduled through your **program coordinator only**. Coaches cannot contact the schools directly to schedule/reschedule practices. It is not guaranteed that practices can always be held due to availability of space and times once games have begun. Bethel Rec. will only allow each squad to practice twice a week. When parents register their children they are committed to attending only two practices a week. Once games begin coaches have the option of having 1-2 practices per week. **Cheer squads can request to practice in your school gyms starting the week of SEPTEMBER 28. Requests to practice indoors must be done through your program coordinator only and must be done well in advance of your scheduled practice.**



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Can't Make the Game

We ask that all coaches find an assistant coach/parent within the first week of practice who can be background checked. In the event a coach is unable to make a game, the assistant can fill in. Games will only be rescheduled due to related weather closures, school closures or unpredicted events. Teams that can't complete a game due to any reason will result in a forfeit. Forfeits will not be rescheduled.

Games Canceled or Rescheduled

Games will only be rescheduled due to related weather closures and unsafe field conditions, school closures or unpredicted events. For updated game/practice status check on our website at bethelrec.org. We will also attempt to send out emails to parents and coaches if games are canceled. **THE RULE IS: If Bethel Schools are closed for any reason, or released early due to inclement weather, all Bethel Rec. activities are canceled.**

Adding Girls to my Roster

The only person that is able to add a child to a roster is your Program Coordinator and the Bethel Rec. Director. To be added to a roster, the child **must** be added to the wait list that is on a first come first served basis. Before any child can practice with the team Bethel Rec. must have their full registration form and payment received.

Refunds Available

Yes. If practices or games don't work, parents may request a refund. They may go to our website at bethelrec.org and complete the on-line refund form. Cheer will receive partial refunds and a \$10 administrative fee will be deducted for all refunds. ***The form must be completed by 3:00PM September 25. After this date, no refunds will be issued.***

Team Photos

Bethel Rec. will schedule the dates and facilities for all team pictures. Coaches will need to contact the photographer directly after game schedules are posted to schedule their team pictures around their game times, preferably at least an hour before games, leaving parents enough time to travel to their games.

Bethel Recreation has contracted with Class Act Portraits. Coaches will only be able to schedule pictures with this company on the dates listed below. ***Teams are not obligated to take team pictures!***
