A Quick Note on Safety

In the spirit of transparency, we want to share that there was an incident involving a few students at our last event. Our Campus Safety and district staff responded immediately to break up the disruptions and ensure everyone remained safe. Following the event, our leadership team conducted a thorough after-action review to build out even stronger safety plans. We have increased our safety staffing, refined our emergency protocols, and established clear behavior expectations to ensure a secure environment moving forward.

Guidelines for Student Awareness and Success

To ensure a smooth, safe, and fun environment for everyone, we want to share some important details so you and your teen know what to expect:

- **First-Day Enrollment:** On the day of initial enrollment, a parent or guardian **must come to the door** with their student. Unless pre-registered.
- **Capacity Limits:** To maintain a safe environment, attendance will be capped at approximately 200 students each night based on daily capacity.
- **Strict Entry & Re-Entry:** Doors open at 5:00 PM. There is **no entry after 7:00 PM**, and we enforce a strict **no re-entry policy** (once a student leaves the building, they cannot return).
- **Identification:** Students must bring their ASB card or provide their student information to enter.
- **Bags:** Please note that **NO bags or backpacks** are allowed inside the venue. Only clear bags and small purses are allowed.
- **Cell Phone Policy:** To ensure a respectful and distraction-free environment, there is **NO recording or taking pictures with phones** permitted during the events.
- **Behavior Expectations:** We want every student to have a great time, which means we are enforcing a strict progressive discipline policy. Students will receive one warning for disruptive behavior; if it continues, they will be sent home and will not be allowed to return for the rest of the summer.
